Dr. Alan John Delhomme, DO, FAAPMR, FAANEM, FAADEP, DABPM, CIME, a devoted husband and father, died suddenly and unexpectedly on June 27, 2010 at his home in La Plata, MD. He was born on May 3, 1945 in Baltimore, MD, and was the only child of the late John A. and Eleanor Delhomme. He graduated from the Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine in 1992 after completing his undergraduate degree at the University of Maryland at College Park. He practiced medicine with NeuroDiagnostic Associates of Maryland in Bel Air, MD and retired in 2007. He also practiced medicine as a physiatrist with Southern Maryland Orthopaedic & Sports Medicine in Waldorf and Leonardtown, MD. Prior to his medical career, he was a percussionist in the "President's Own" United States Marine Band.
