Albert L. Jenkins, 94, of Indian Head, MD passed away on Thursday, August 1, 2024 in the company of his wife.

Born on March 31, 1930 in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late Eugene A. Jenkins, Sr. and Olga Thee Jenkins.

Called Louis by his family and Al by his friends in the military, he grew up on the Naval Base in Indian Head. He joined the Naval Reserves at 17 and attended the University of Maryland, College Park. Next, he joined the Air Force, flew jets and served in the military until retiring at the rank of Lieutenant Colonel.
