



## Alexander "Lexi" George Diachenko

December 5, 1960 - July 3, 2022

Alexander George Diachenko, 61, of La Plata, Maryland, passed away at his home on July 3, 2022.

Born on December 5, 1960 in Syracuse, New York, he was the son of the late Joseph Diachenko and Sandra Gambeski Diachenko. Fondly known as "Lexi", he was a graduate of La Plata High School Class of '78 and earned his Bachelor's Degree from the University of Maryland. Lexi was a contract Medical Transcriptionist for several hospitals and a caregiver. He enjoyed gardening, bird watching, the Presidential Inaugurations, judging the Charles County Science Fair, following the old Washington Redskins team, and downhill skiing in Canada and Utah.

Lexi is survived by his siblings Beth Collier and her husband Burt, Joseph Diachenko and his wife Alyona; nephew Max and niece Anastasiya; his latest cat Euripedes ("Rip"), who is available for adoption at the Charles County Humane Society.
