Alice "Alicia" Morrison passed away Monday, June 15, 2026 at her home in White Plains, MD. She was under the care of The Hospice of the Chesapeake with her loving husband of 47 years at her side.

Alicia was born January 17, 1943 in Tampa, FL to Reynaldo & Diamela Linares and raised with her younger brother, Reynaldo Linares Jr.

Alicia had a love of life, a smile and a pleasant word for everyone she met. She loved all animals, but especially her Yorkies. She enjoyed being a mother, a wife, quilting, embroidering, and riding motorcycles with her husband and friends. Alicia and her husband spent a lot of time touring throughout the United States on a very comfortable touring motorcycle.

Alicia spent over twenty years as the spouse of a member of the Air Force. She has traveled and lived throughout the United States and Europe. When her husband retired from the Air Force in Washington DC, she was working at Andrews Office Products in Capitol Heights, MD. Alicia retired from there in 1999, when she and her husband purchased Somethin' Special, LLC, an embroidery and awards business, in White Plains, MD. They successfully ran and grew that business until they sold it and retired in 2016.

Alicia was very active in the community wherever she lived. She was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star, a board member for the Humane Society of Charles County for many years, a member of Quilter's Guild of Southern Maryland for several years, as well as a member of, or associated with various motorcycle clubs. She and her husband were selected as

Maryland State Couple of the Year in 1998 for Goldwing Road Riders Motorcycle Club.

Alicia was preceded in death by her parents, Reynaldo and Diamela Linares. She is survived by her devoted husband, Lloyd Morrison; their children, Maria (Vic) Krepacki, Michael (Julie) Morrison, and Joseph (Catherine) Maseda; eight grandchildren, and five great-grandchildren; and three cousins that she grew-up with in Florida.
