March 26, 1914 - May 13, 2011

Alvin Gustave Fuerth of La Plata, Maryland, died on Friday, May 13, 2011 in Clinton, MD. He was 97 years old.

Mr. Fuerth was an only child. He became an Eagle Scout at the age of 15 and graduated from Columbia High School in Maplewood, NJ in 1932. He remained with the Boy Scouts as a Scout Master for many years after that. He worked as a Computer Programmer for 46 years with Prudential Insurance Company, retiring in 1979. He was a Veteran of the United States Army, having served during World War II as a Combat Infantry Platoon Staff Sergeant in the 65th Division of General Patton's 3rd Army. He lived in Springfield, NJ for many years and upon his retirement, moved to Waldorf, MD for 8 years to spend time with his young grandchildren. He then lived in retirement communities in Brick, NJ and Fredericksburg, VA before moving back to Maryland on his 97th birthday on March 26, 2011. He loved crossword puzzles in the daily newspaper and, most of all, he enjoyed being with his family.

Son of the late Gustave William Fuerth and the late Edith Adele Van Loo Fuerth.

Predeceased by his parents.

Survived by his wife of 71 years, Mary Adele Fuerth; one daughter, Susan J. (Charles) Brewer of La Plata, MD; and two grandchildren, Jeffrey M. (Heather) Brewer of Albany, NY and Steven A. (Shana) Brewer of Plainsboro, NJ. Also survived by five great-grandchildren, Hannah, Joseph, Ben, Jackson and Anderson Brewer.
