Anita Kay Warnes, 68, of Waldorf, Maryland, passed away on Tuesday, July 23, 2024 at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata, in the company of her son, Erik, and his partner, Kaitlyn.

Born on October 13, 1955 in Weston, West Virginia, she was the daughter of the late Edsel Ray Lynch and Virginia Lee Jones. Anita was a Circulation Manager for the College of Southern Maryland, as well as a former stay-at-home mom and school teacher. She enjoyed woodworking, knitting, crocheting, sewing, and running her own business making Barbie clothes. Anita was the "Handy Woman" around the house. Her home improvement projects included completely remodeling the bathrooms, kitchen, and creating a pond on the property. In addition to her parents, Anita is preceded in death by her husband, John L. Warnes.
