Anthony Eldridge Whittington, 86, of Brandywine, MD, died July 5, 2011, at Southern Maryland Hospital Center, Clinton, MD.

Mr. Whittington grew up on a farm and went to Old Mill School at Leeland and Marlboro School in Upper Marlboro, MD. He joined the Navy in 1943 and wanted to make a career there but when his father died, he decided to return home to help his mother and brothers and sisters. He was a World War II veteran of the United States Navy. In 1959 he married his wife Lorraine Hyde of Brandywine, MD. He later worked for Safeway Warehouse and retired from there due to heart problems. He enjoyed working in his garden and around his house. He loved good country music "Don Williams" and spending time with family, especially his grandchildren, Shelby and Nicholas.
