June 9, 1931 - December 27, 2008

Bob Leo Murphy of Waldorf, Maryland, died at his home on Saturday, December 27, 2008. He was 77 years old.

Born on June 9, 1931, in Barton, Missouri, he was the son of the late Susie Ethel Boggs and Roy Edward Murphy. Mr. Murphy served in the U. S.
