Every time we went, even with different horses, she was always out in front of me and I was dodging mud from her horse's hooves! Those clumps of mud hurt! Sometimes, I would just stop and wait till she got to the edge of the woods and then I would gallop up to meet her. We would walk our horses through the woods and talk. We always had a great time together. We had fun! We lost touch through the last decade or two because of life.*

Death is what brought us back in touch with the passing of her Mom. And before that, Dave went up to help his Mom get to doctors appointments and visit when she was in the rehab place. And finally at the funeral home. Then when their brother Donald passed this past July, we were brought together again. Because of Brenda, Dave was able to talk with his brother before he passed and Dave is forever grateful for that! I went up to Waldorf to get my car detailed and I stopped by the house. We ended up talking on the phone and I didn't have a chance to go inside. The last thing she said to me was wanting to get the family together for a picnic. Unfortunately, that never happened. She was always kind and sweet. The last thing I told her was that no matter what, we are family and we can always talk! Our hearts are heavy and we will miss her so much.
