Felder William "Buddy" Still Jr. of La Plata, MD, died suddenly at his home on Saturday, June 13, 2015. He was 57 years old.

Born on December 5, 1957 in Kansas City, MO, Buddy is the son of Mary Eleanor Graves Still and the late Felder William Still Sr. Buddy was an Electric Planner for NRG at the Morgantown plant in Newburg, MD.
