



## Calvin Junior Foote Sr.

July 17, 1939 - December 19, 2016

Calvin Junior Foote, Sr., age 77 of Waldorf, Maryland died December 19, 2016 at his residence with Hospice.

Calvin was a Veteran of the United States Air Force, having served from 1956 through 1962 during the Vietnam conflict. He worked 38 years as an elevator mechanic with the Local #10 National Elevator Industry Union. He was a member, along with his wife, at Calvary Grace Assembly of God Church in La Plata. He was a former coach of T-ball and football in Waldorf and an avid Washington Redskin fan and Washington Nationals fan. He most enjoyed being with family, especially his grandchildren.

He was the son of Chester Franklin Foote and Irma Rose Squires Foot. In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his son, Michael Foote.
