



## Carl Francis Vogt

November 20, 1943 - October 13, 2019

Carl Francis Vogt, age 75, of Huntingtown, MD, passed away on October 13, 2019.

Carl was a Contracts Manager with Manpower Group. He was a Veteran of the United States Air Force, having served in support of the Vietnam Conflict, and was of the Catholic faith.

He was a member of the Joseph B. Garity American Legion Post #562 in Ridgewood, NY, where he was a former Post Commander, the Loyal Order of Moose Lodge #2393 in Patuxent, MD, and the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post #10081 in Bel Alton, MD, where he was a former Post Commander in 2005. Carl also served as the State Commander for the Department of Maryland Veterans of Foreign Wars from 2012-2013. He was also a member of the Calvert Elks Lodge #2620. Carl served as the State President of the Maryland-Delaware-D.C. Elks Association from 2013-2014 and was a former District Deputy, Exalted Ruler, and was currently serving as the Chairman of the Trustees of the Calvert Elks Lodge.

Carl was son of the late Carl Heinz Vogt and the late Martha Schneider Vogt. In addition to his parent, Carl was preceded in death by one brother, Guenther E. Vogt.

He is survived by his loving wife, Mary Elizabeth Ireson Cardinal-Vogt; one son, Lawrence Vogt, and his wife Meredith, of Palm Cost, FL; one brother, Arnold Vogt, and his wife Brigitte, of Greensboro, NC; and one sister, Ingrid Herbel of Mount Pocono, PA.

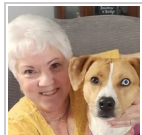
