Carol Ann White, age 75 of Waldorf, Maryland died December 22, 2016 at Charles County Hospice House in Waldorf, Maryland.

Carol was a settlement agent with Title & Law Offices for 35 plus years and a part-time real estate agent for most of her life, working with Davis Real Estate. She was a member of Our Lady Help of Christians Catholic Church in Waldorf where she was also a member of the choir. She also belonged to the Red Hats Club, the Tea Club, NARF, and the Lady Lioness Club. She volunteered with Help for the Alzheimer's Association. 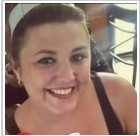
