September 17, 1928 - November 28, 2009

Catherine I. Ayling, of Prince Frederick, MD, formerly of La Plata, MD, died on Saturday, November 28, 2009, at Holy Cross Hospital in Silver Spring, MD. She was 81 years old.

Born on September 17, 1928, in White Plains, MD, she was the daughter of the late Alice Catherine Lucas and the late Thomas Augustus Simpson. A lifelong resident of Southern Maryland, Ms. Ayling worked as a mailing clerk for Diversified Mailing and later for Capital Fulfillment in Waldorf.
