



## Catherine Bainbridge

June 21, 1916 - November 30, 2011

Catherine Connors Bainbridge of Waldorf, MD died on Wednesday, November 30, 2011 at Fenwick Landing in Waldorf, MD. She was 95 years old.

Mrs. Bainbridge was an Office Manager for 11 years at NASA (United States Government). Born June 21, 1916 in Old Forge, PA, she was one of six children. After her marriage in 1938, Mrs. Bainbridge and her husband moved to Washington, DC. They celebrated their 50th anniversary in 1988. Mrs. Bainbridge retired from NASA in 1976 and previously worked for the Navy Department during World War II, Lansburgh's Department Store, and the A&P Grocery Store. Mrs. Bainbridge was a devoted wife, loving mother, and grandmother who enjoyed gardening, baking, sewing, and quilting. She was always ready to help whenever and wherever she was needed.
