Charles Raymond Bowling, 65, of Allens Fresh, Maryland, passed on January 22, 2018.

Chuck was raised and worked on the family farm at Allens Fresh for many years. He ended his professional career in July 2008, retiring as Service Manager with Suburban Propane.
