Charles James Coghlan, age 45, died on April 2, 2011.

He was a Charles County Volunteer Firefighter and EMT Instructor, a Prince George's County Professional Firefighter, and a United States Coast Guard Veteran of the Persian Gulf War (memorialized in the 2004 edition of The Foundation for Coast Guard History, pictured with his gun boat crew in the Persian Gulf War), and a McDonough High School graduate with an Associate Degree from the College of Southern Maryland (CSM). He recently served as the civilian head of the U.S.C.G. Nationwide Watch Qualifications Training Program, and was a HAZTRAIN, Inc.
