February 2, 1939 - May 17, 2011

Charles Richard Dashiell, Jr., 72, of King George, VA, formerly of Hampstead, MD, died May 17, 2011, at Mary Washington Hospital, Fredericksburg, VA.

Charlie graduated from Milford Mill High School on June 4, 1959. He spent the next year at the University of Baltimore and focused on drafting and engineering pursuits. After being honorably discharged from the U.S. Army in 1964 he began what became his life's work in the Horse Industry. Beginning with retail work he became interested in repair and custom work associated with equine equipment. He then merged the two entities and for 10 - 12 years was crisscrossing the country with several mobile tack shops.

Over the past 28 years he shifted his focus to the repair of equine equipment attending shows in the tri-state area. In addition, he has maintained the responsibility of Director of Vendor Management for the Upperville Colt and Horse Show, an event he looked forward to attending each and every year.

Born February 2, 1939, in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of late Charles R. Dashiell and late Margaret M. Dashiell.

Predeceased by his parents.

He is survived by companion and partner, Constance Ditmore; daughter, Janna Pinckney and her husband Carl Pinckney of La Plata; grandchildren, Danielle "Dannie" Griffin, age 26, Ceala Naomi Pinckney, age 12 and Jordan Elaine Pinckney, age 8.
