Charles Reginald "Reggie" Dyson, Sr., 82, of Hughesville, MD, died April 9, 2011, at Chesapeake Shores Nursing Home, Lexington Park, MD.

Mr. Dyson was Chief Lineman for 38 years with Southern Maryland Electric Coop.
