Charles Hess, 90, of Accokeek, MD, passed away November 11, 2008, in Clinton, MD.

Mr. Hess was a real estate broker and owner of Accokeek Realty for 42 years. Prior to his real estate career, he spent 27 years working with the Department of the Navy in Washington, DC. He was a veteran of the United States Army having served during World War II and was awarded the Purple Heart.
