Charles Henry Menke of Clinton, MD died on Sunday, February 24, 2013 at his residence with Hospice. He was 89 years old.

Born December 8, 1923 in Gleason, WV, he was the son of late Henry Arthur Menke and the late Alma Ruth Menke. He was also preceded in death by his wife, Jeanne Rossman Menke and one sister, Leona Hardesty.

He is survived by two sons, Timothy Earl Menke of Clinton, MD and Matthew C. Menke and his wife Cathy of Accokeek, MD; three grandchildren, Eric Menke, Melissa Menke, and Sarah Menke. He is also survived by 2 great grandchildren.

Mr. Menke was a cartographer with the Defense Mapping Agency (U. S. Government) and was a veteran of the United States Navy, having served during World War II and the Korean conflict. He was also a member of Unity Presbyterian Church in Temple Hills, MD. He was active in the Surratts Seniors Club and the Masonic Lodge (where he was master). He was an alumni of the University of West Virginia College, a past boy scouts leader, and a coach with Clinton Boys Club. He loved traveling and dancing with his wife.
