Charles "Skippy" Robert Simpson, age 64 of White Plains, MD, died suddenly on June 11, 2015 at Southern MD Hospital Center in Clinton, MD.

Skippy was an Environmental Resources Manager with the Department of Defense (U.S. Government) for 20 plus years and was a 1968 graduate of La Plata High School.
