



Charles Wright "Charlie" Wills

August 7, 1940 - November 6, 2018

Charles Wright "Charlie" Wills, 78 of Indian Head, Maryland, died November 6, 2018 at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata, Maryland.

Charlie was a Safety Inspector with G.S.A. for 30 plus years and was a member of St. Mary Star of the Sea Catholic Church in Indian Head, Maryland.

He was also a past EMS Chief, past President, a Life Member, and a Chaplain for the Potomac Heights Volunteer Fire Department of Rescue Squad where he provided 64 years of active service to the community – he has held numerous positions at the county and state level and was one of the most well-known EMT instructors ever.

He was the son of Doyne R. Wills, Sr. and Clara M. Latham Wills. In addition to his parents, he is also predeceased by his brothers, Harry L. Wills and Doyne R. Wills, Jr.

He is survived by his son, Charles M. Wills (Shewana); his daughter, Andrea M. Wills-Hooper (Sammy); his sister, Mollie Johnson; and his grandchildren, Makenzie and Aidan Hooper.

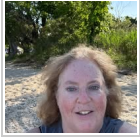
