*I encourage you to always reflect on the number of family and friends who were able to attend (during the pandemic) the viewing, Mass at St. Peter's, and a farewell at the grave site. It was such a surreal moment when the young Marines folded "the American Flag" and one knelt before you and so lovingly placed the Flag into your hands whispering words of appreciation from a grateful nation for Chester's service to his country -- followed by another young Marine playing "final taps". Rest well young Marine.*

*You will think often of Chester -- remembering when he would arrive home from work, and he would say, "The Sweet One is home." You would follow up by saying, "I know, I've been here all day." I can hear him agreeing! The affection held between the two of you will not end. Chester will forever be with you -- whether you "feel him" in that quiet air when reading or watching TV, when you may sense him as a drape moves, when a special memento suddenly falls from the mantle as you and your children are sharing a "hug-a-lug". He's with YOU!*

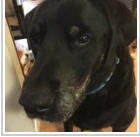
