Concettina Marie (Marino) Carpentiere, 101, of Newburg, Maryland, died on Monday, September 10, 2007 at the Genesis La Plata Center in La Plata, MD.

Born on May 18, 1906 in Middletown, CT, she is the daughter of the late Giuseppina (Bartolotta) and Antonio Marino. She spent most of her life in Middletown.
