Daniel Raymond "Danny" Bowes, age 71 of La Plata, Maryland, died suddenly at his residence on August 4, 2017.

Danny was a Mortgage Banker for 40 plus years and a long-time member and volunteer at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in La Plata and Mt. Carmel Monastery in Port Tobacco. He was also a member of the Archbishop Neale Knights of Columbus Council. He enjoyed collecting antique guns and was known for his Hawaiian shirts. 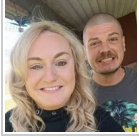
