Daniel Norris Taylor (Dan/Danny)

On Saturday, January 6, 2018, Dan passed away unexpectedly.

Born in Prince Frederick, Maryland, to John (Jack) and Florence (Flo) Taylor, he was a life long resident of La Plata. He graduated from La Plata High School in 1958. Mr. Taylor served in the United States Navy from 1958 to 1962. As a signalman on the U.S.S Conway, he participated in photographing Soviet vessels during the Cuban missile crisis. His ship was also present during the re-entry of Gus Grissom's space capsule. He was an avid cyclist who could be found on the Indian Head Rail Trail several times a week and had just returned from a vacation in Florida where he logged several miles on the Gainesville to Hawthorne trail.

Dan is survived by his wife, Donna Thomas Taylor; his children, Christopher Taylor and Catherine Taylor, his grandson, Dylan Taylor; and his brother and sister-in-law, John and Kathy Taylor.
