David Christopher "Stickman" Meyers, age 47 of Waldorf, Maryland died May 28, 2017 at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata, Maryland.

David was a self-employed Electronic Repair Technician for 23 years. He was known worldwide as the founder of Southern Maryland All Radio Telecommunications (SMART) and creator/builder of Ass Kicker (No Name Amps). He was also the king of keydowns.

He was the son of David Richard Meyers and Linda Diane Ney White. He was predeceased by his half-brother, Bubby Jenkins.

In addition to his parents, he is survived by his wife, Tina Michelle Meyers; his sons, Christopher A. Meyers, Devon M. Meyers, and Trevor A. 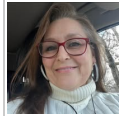
