Donald Gilbert Hood of Brandywine, MD died on July 23, 2014 at the Bayview Medical Center in Baltimore, MD. He was 67 years old.

Donald was a devoted and most loving husband, father, grandfather, son, brother, uncle, and friend. He spent most of his youth playing sports and at one time had scouts “gawking” at his talents. His love for music was shown through jamming in his band “Tin Soup” or just cranking it up on the stereo on a Friday night with the family. His crowning achievement though, through his family’s eyes, was being the rock of the Hood family. He was someone who was always there no matter what.
