



## Earl Raymond Mathews

July 7, 1938 - October 9, 2017

Earl Raymond Mathews, age 79 of Bryans Road, Maryland, died October 9, 2017 at his residence.

Earl was a self-employed carpenter for 60 plus years and was of the Baptist faith. He was an avid Washington Nationals and Washington Redskins fan.
