Edmund R. Guido (62 years of age) of Upper Marlboro, MD passed away peacefully in his sleep on Monday, August 2, 2010 at his home with his loving wife by his side. Mr. Guido was born in Morgantown, WV son of the late Ettore and Erma Guido and brother of the late James Guido. Ed was a successful business entrepreneur who also had a passion for boxing. Mr. Guido not only promoted professional boxing in the Washington Metropolitan area, but was very committed to coaching many young amateur and professional boxers over his lifetime. Mr. Guido was inducted into the Washington, DC Boxing Hall of Fame in 2001. The Senate of Maryland passed a resolution in 1979 in recognition of his being honored as Citizen Lifesaver of the Year by the Clinton Volunteer Fire Department. He also received in 1977 from the House of Delegates of Maryland an Official Citation in recognition of his outstanding contribution to amateur boxing in Prince George's County. Ed was devoted to his family and was a loving husband, father, and grandfather. He is survived by his wife, Deborah, his children, Debi, George (Julie), Parrish, and Eric (Ani), a sister, Sharon (Steve), and eight beloved grandchildren: Heather, Dominic, Gabrielle, Madeline, Olivia, Jonathan, Sevan, and Alique.
