Edward William Bowen, 60, of Waldorf, MD, died February 28, 2009, at Southern Maryland Hospital Center, Clinton, MD.

Mr. Bowen was a bulk mail clerk for 37 years with the U.S. Postal Service at Central Avenue, MD. He was the veteran of the U.S. Army having served from 1967 to 1969. He was a stamp collector, long-time blood donor to the American Red Cross, and a member of the American Legion Post, Waldorf, MD.
