



## Edward Andrew Gawthrop

Edward A. Gawthrop, “Mr. Ed/Pop” 86, of White Plains, Maryland, passed away Wednesday, August 16, 2023, at Sagepoint Senior Living Center.

Born February 11, 1937, in Washington DC, he was the son of the late Arthur “Tommy” and Josephine Gawthrop. Ed grew up in Indian Head, MD and graduated from Lackey High School in 1955, Salutatorian.
