Edward Howard Hardy, 73, of Port Tobacco, MD, died May 19, 2011, at Genesis La Plata Center.

Mr. Hardy was a Tower Construction Supervisor with PEPCO in Washington, DC offices for 31 years. He was a veteran of the United States Marine Corps having served during the Korean Conflict where he was a Marine Sniper and award-winning shooting team member.
