Elizabeth Ann Hale, 86, of La Plata, Maryland passed away peacefully on September 13, 2025, at home.

Born in Waynesburg, Pennsylvania, March 8, 1939, Ann graduated from Uniontown School of Nursing and became a Registered Nurse.
