Ernest "Ernie" Lee Sigmon, Sr., 84, of Waldorf, MD, passed on January 23, 2018.

He was born in Hiawatha, West Virginia, a small coal mining town, on May 21, 1933 to Edward and Annie (Cook) Sigmon.
