Ethyl M. Dubois of Waldorf, MD, died on Tuesday, December 18, 2012 at her friend's residence. She was 75 years old.

Born on September 8, 1937 in Englewood, New Jersey, she was the daughter of the late Melvin Dubois and the late Helen Sprague Dubois. Ms Dubois served in the U. S. Navy from 1960 to 1962 before being Honorably Discharged at the rank of Ensign. She was an Educator with the Prince George's School System and taught Chemistry at the Oxon Hill High School. She was an active member of the Church of Jesus Christ Latter Day Saints. Ms Dubois served as a missionary in Bolivia for several years. She was a founding member of a Spanish speaking LDS congregation in Camp Springs. Ms Dubois also taught religious instruction at the church to high school students. She was a proud breeder of prize-winning show cats that won numerous awards and was an avid Washington Redskins fan.
