Charles County Public Schools for 30 plus years. She, herself, earned her GED from the State of MD and helped educate others with the same goal. Over the years, Fran and Marty welcomed family members into their loving and stable home. Their house was the neighborhood gathering place for kids to play. It is with this legacy that we can remember the kindness and warmth that they shared.
