Frank Edwin Douglas, 82 of Newburg, MD passed away at his residence on January 29, 2016.

He was born on May 1, 1933 in Baltimore, MD to the late Frank Ernest and Julia Evelyn Schanfelter Douglas.

Frank retired from the Defense Mapping Agency in June of 1988 after 30 plus years of service as a Cartographer. He served in the United States Army from 1954-1956. Frank was an avid fisherman who enjoyed spending time on the water in his boat "Reeliving". He also enjoyed his time in his workshop, especially woodworking. He was a member of the United States Coast Guard Auxillary and the Knights of Columbus.

In addition to his parents he is predeceased by one son, Jeff Balawajder; one brother and one sister.

He is survived by his wife of 25 years Virginia E. Douglas; four daughters Debra "Lynn" Negrón, Christi Blaney, Carol Erickson and Teresa Hixon Viamonte; nine grandchildren; five great-grandchildren; three sisters; one brother and many dear neighbors and friends.
