Garland Montgomery "Paw Paw" Bruce of Pomfret, MD died on May 26, 2014 at the Washington Hospital Center in Washington, DC. He was 79 years old.

Mr. Bruce was an operating engineer with Delta Equipment in Washington, DC for 50 plus years and a veteran of the U. S. Army, having served from 1957-1959 and was of the Baptist faith.
