George Le Roy Long of Denton, MD, died on Thursday, September 17, 2009, at the Memorial Hospital at Easton, MD. He was 69 years old.

Born on August 31, 1940, in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late Frances Edna Dement and the late George Wellington Long.

He served in the U. S. Air Force before being Honorably Discharged in 1961 at the rank of Airman Basic. He was an ace facilities mechanic for the U.S. Post Office at the Largo, MD, facility for many years. A member of the Tuckahoe Steam and Gas Association, the Moose, and the Maryland Farm Museum, George was also a member of the Cecil Militia, doing re-inactments of the 1700's. He also enjoyed fishing, hunting, and collecting guns and ammo, mostly the black powder type. George was an avid train fan, especially steam locomotives, and had models in various gauges and his layouts would include replicas of the militia.

In addition to his parents, George was preceded in death by his brother, Richard Melvin "Dickie" Long.

He is survived by his wife, Hilda G. Long; sons, Keith and his wife Jean Long, Bill and his wife Cathe Long; grandchildren, Nicholas Long, Alexander Long, Kathryn Long, Elizabeth Long and Breanna Long; also survived by a sister-in-law, nieces, nephew, cousins, other relatives and friends.
