



## George Henry McLaughlin

June 28, 1953 - June 8, 2014

George Henry McLaughlin of Brandywine, MD died on June 8, 2014 at the Georgetown University Hospital in Washington, DC. He was 63 years old.

George was a computer programmer with the Bureau of Census at the Department of Commerce where he received a gold and silver medal for his work on the census and was a member/treasurer of the St. Thomas Croom Episcopal Church parish and a vestry member. He was avid in golf and sports in general.
