Captain Roy graduated from the USCG Academy in the summer of 1951. His Coast Guard Aviation career spanned 25 years and over 6,000 flight hours in every aircraft type in USCG inventory. Captain Roy participated in hundreds of air rescue missions throughout his career and was awarded many metals and commendations for his selfless and brave service. In 1972 Captain Roy took command of Coast Guard Airbase, Kodiak, Alaska. In 1974 Captain Roy transferred for his final tour to USCG Headquarters as Deputy Chief of Staff. In this position Captain Roy personally selected and directed the procurement of much of the Coast Guards current modern aviation assets to include the French Falcón Jet and Dauphine Helicopters.

He is the son of the late Esther and the late George John Roy Sr., also predeceased by his wife, the late Mary Jacquelin Ashley Roy.

He is the proud father of 3 children, Patricia Ann Roy, George John Roy III, and Todd Asher Roy; the grandfather of 7 grandchildren, Hunter Roy Coates, George John Roy IV, Jared Doyle Roy, Patrick Roy, Zachery Bernui Roy, Blaine Asher Roy, and Chance Austin Roy; the great grandfather of 2 great grandchildren, Hanna and Dayna Coates; the brother of Ester Jean Purnell of Wellington, FL.

His Visitation will be on Friday, December 7, 2012 from 9AM until his Funeral Service at 11AM at New Life Wesleyan Chapel, La Plata, Maryland 20646.
