



## Glenwood Allen Dudley

May 4, 1934 - December 10, 2020

Glenwood Allen Dudley, age 86 of Nanjemoy, Maryland, passed away at his home on Thursday, December 10, 2020 surrounded by his family.

Born at Efton Hills in Grayton, Maryland on May 4, 1934, he was the son of the late Roby Hammond and Alice Novella (Henderson) Dudley and was one of 11 children. In addition to his parents, he is preceded in death by his wife, Joyce; his two great granddaughters, Alexis and Rexx Larkin, three sisters, and six brothers.

He is survived by his four children, Marty (Nancy), Connie (Skip), Robin (Butch), and Tony (Mary), all of Nanjemoy, Maryland; his brother, George Dudley (Barbara) of Marbury, Maryland; 12 grandchildren; 15 great grandchildren; and a host of nieces and nephews.

His greatest love was his wife, Joyce, his children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren and working in the fields with his family up until his time of death. He retired from the Federal Government after 36 years of service. Following his retirement, he worked at County Drug for 10 years delivering prescriptions to those unable to leave their homes. He loved being able to help others and was loved by all who looked forward to his visits, always with a smile and kind words. He accepted the Lord as his Savior at a young age and served faithfully at Nanjemoy Baptist Church in many capacities until the

time of his death.

Visitation on Wednesday, December 16, 2020 from 10-11:30AM at Nanjemoy Baptist Church. However, due to Covid 19 restrictions and limited seating, the funeral service will be for family only with Pastor Michael Spencer and Bo Hancock officiating. Interment to follow at the church cemetery. There will be no repass following the service.

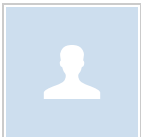
