



## Gregory Ray Armstrong

February 20, 1957 - March 21, 2015

Gregory Ray Armstrong, age 58 of La Plata, MD, died on March 21, 2015 at the Charles County Hospice House in Waldorf, MD.

Gregory was a Retired Master Chief with the United States Navy, having served 20 years.
