July 14, 1921 - March 28, 2009

Harry Frederick Gilmer, 87, of Indian Head, MD, died March 28, 2009, at Charlotte Hall Veterans Home.

Mr. Gilmer was a Powder Plant worker with the Naval Ordnance Station, Indian Head, MD, for 22 years. He was a life member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, the American Legion Post in Indian Head, MD, and AMVETS. He was a veteran of the United States Army having served during World War II and was the recipient of two Purple Hearts.

Born July 14, 1921, in Webster, PA, he was the son of the late Harry Gilmer and the late Goldie Weaver Gilmer.
