September 2, 1920 - September 14, 2012

Henry Emmitt Stipp of Falls Church, VA died on Friday, September 14, 2012 at Virginia Hospital Center in Arlington, VA. He was 92 years old.

Born on September 2, 1920 in Niagara Falls, New York, he was the son of the late Verna Katherine Houck and the late Henry B. Stipp. Mr. Stipp received his Master's Degree at the University of Buffalo. As a Lieutenant in the U. S. Army during World War II, he served with the Corps of Engineers in the South Pacific. Following the war, he worked as a geologist for the U. S. Government where he published numerous articles on rocks and minerals throughout the world. He was an avid horticulturalist who planted trees from twigs in his spare time. Mr. Stipp was a member of the American Legion Post 176 in Springfield, VA.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, the late Betty Ann Wirth Stipp and his brother the late Robert Stipp.

He is survived by his step-son Tom Brett of Waldorf, MD; his step-daughter Colleen Brett of Waldorf; his brother Edwin Stipp of Florida; his sister Grace Warner of California; his grandson Robert Brett; many nieces and nephews.
