



## Herbert Randolph Crowder

October 6, 1928 - December 30, 2014

Herbert Randolph Crowder, age 86, of White Plains, MD died on December 30, 2014 at the Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore City, MD. Born in Covington, VA, he moved to Charles County in 1953.

He is the son of the late Cecil Thomas Crowder and the late Mabel Virginia Caldwell Crowder. He is also predeceased by his brothers, Richard C. Caldwell and Gilbert B. Crowder; his sister, Mildred Crowder; his daughter-in-law, Gayle M. Crowder; and his son-in-law, John T. Whitley.

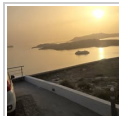
