



Herbert Arthur Leeman Sr.

March 5, 1934 - September 18, 2015

Herbert Arthur Leeman Sr. of Clinton, Maryland, died on Friday, September 18, 2015 at his home. He was 81 years old.

Born on March 5, 1934 in Washington, DC, he was the son of the late Goldie E. Leeman and the late James E. Leeman. Mr. Leeman served in the U. S. Army from 1956 until he was Honorably Discharged in 1958. He then worked different jobs to support his family, retiring from Peoples Life before driving a school bus for the Prince George's School System. He was a life member of the Clinton Fire Department, a member of the Moose and was active with the Boy Scouts when his sons were involved in scouting. Mr. Leeman enjoyed camping, crabbing, working on cars, but mostly spending time with family and friends.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Leeman was preceded in death by his brother, James E. Leeman III.

He is survived by his wife, Joyce A. Leeman; his children Vivian Rowe and her significant other Billy, Herbert Leeman Jr. and his wife Susan, Wayne Leeman Sr. and his wife Arlene, Darin Leeman and his wife Jennifer; his brother Robert J. Leeman; 11 grandchildren and 5 with one on the way great grandchildren.
