Howard R. Bowles, 90, of Upper Marlboro, Maryland, passed away on Friday, May 19, 2023 at the University of Maryland Charles Regional Medical Center in La Plata.

Born on October 14, 1932 in Roselle, New Jersey, he was the son of the late Mehallie Bowles and Augusta Bowles. Howard served in the U. S. Army during the Korean War until he was Honorably Discharged at the rank of Specialist Second Class. He was an executive sales manager for the Washington Post.
